What is this project?

Walk Wheel Cycle Trust, formerly Sustrans, is working with Cornwall Council and Torpoint Town Council to develop a Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP) for Torpoint, Rame Peninsula and St Germans.

Why this is important?

An LCWIP is a plan that helps councils and communities work together to make walking, wheeling, and cycling safer and easier. It focuses on linking and improving areas in towns, villages, and important places in ways that meet local needs.

How are we going to deliver this?

We're working step by step to learn where people walk, wheel, and cycle, what gets in the way, and how we can make routes better. We're starting with local knowledge, mapping key journeys, and planning future improvements.

What will be the outcome?

The goal is to create safer and easier routes for walking, wheeling, and cycling. These changes will help people who already use these ways to get around - and encourage more people to give them a try.
